### JUNIATA CLOSES OUT 2008 CAMPAIGN

Juniata College will wrap up its 2008 season this Saturday at Knox Stadium when it hosts Dickinson College. The Eagles will be looking for a second conference victory to end their season, and will be trying to send off their seniors with a win.

Juniata will be recognizing its nine seniors during pre-game ceremonies. Seniors playing their final game on Saturday are: student-assistant coach Eric Baker, DL Justin Bell, RB Aaron Rodgers, DB Bryan Jung, QB Jay Leonard, LB John Perna, LB Josh Roy, WR Chad Steiner, and DL Sean Vanderlin.

### THE SERIES

This will be the 20th meeting between Juniata and Dickinson, with the Red Devils holding a 11-8 advantage in the series. This will be the seventh straight season the two schools have clashed on the gridiron, with Dickinson winning the last five meetings.

Dickinson won last season's matchup in Huntingdon, 41-14. The Eagles racked up 362 yards of total offense against the Red Devils, but Dickinson finished with 493 yards of offense and built a 41-0 lead before Juniata got on the scoreboard in the fourth quarter.

The last Juniata victory in the series was a 26-9 win in Carlisle in 2002. The Blue and Gold's last win over the Red Devils in Huntingdon was back in 1956, when Juniata defeated Dickinson 44-13.

### BAIRD NAMED CENTENNIAL DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Freshman defensive back Jordan Baird was named the Centennial Conference's Defensive Player of the Week, for his performance last Saturday against Johns Hopkins University.

Baird finished with 11 total tackles in Juniata's 12-0 loss at Johns Hopkins, including a game-high nine unassisted tackles, along with four forced fumbles and one fumble recovery. Baird forced fumbles on three of Johns Hopkins' first four possessions; one of those was on the Juniata six-yard line.

The four forced fumbles ties an NCAA Division III record for most forced fumbles in a single game, matching the mark set by Thomas More's Nick Rice, who recorded four forced fumbles against Franklin College on Oct. 11, 2002.

Baird is the second Juniata player this season to earn a Centennial weekly honor; kicker Andrew Masullo received a share of the Special Teams Player of the Week award following Juniata's 12-10 victory over McDaniel on October 4.

Punter Owen Phillips was named to the Centennial's Weekly Honor Roll, after recording eight punts for 273 yards – an average of 34.1 yards per punt – in the loss to the Blue Jays.

### LAST TIME OUT: Johns Hopkins 12, Juniata 0

Johns Hopkins University scored twice in the second half on its way to a 12-0 win over Juniata College, Saturday at Homewood Field in Baltimore, Md.

Juniata turned in another strong defensive effort, forcing fumbles on Johns Hopkins' first two possessions and holding the Blue Jay offense scoreless in the first half, with just 12 points for the entire game. Johns Hopkins entered the game ranked third in the league in scoring, averaging 29.3 points per game.

Juniata was led by Tyler Hall with 15 total tackles, including seven solo stops. Josh Roy had his sixth straight game with at least 10 tackles, finishing with 12 total tackles against the Blue Jays. Jordan Baird tallied 11 tackles, including a game-high nine unassisted, with one fumble recovery to go with the four fumbles forced.

Offensively, Juniata mustered 171 yards of total offense, led by Jay Leonard's 15-of-35 passing for 125 yards. Chad Steiner hauled in five of those passes for 40 yards, while Lance Curry also had five passes for 39 yards. Dan Zentz carried 14 times for 30 of Juniata's 46 yards of total rushing.

Johns Hopkins finished with 481 yards of total offense, paced by Andrew Kase's 180 yards rushing on 30 carries. The Blue Jays had 253 yards through the air on Hewitt Tomlin's 20-of-30 passing performance.

**PRESEASON NOTES**

- Senior QB Jay Leonard, senior WR Chad Steiner, senior LB Josh Roy, and junior DB Brandon Spayd will be Juniata's team captains for 2008, as voted by their teammates.
- Juniata was picked to finish ninth in the Centennial in 2008, in preseason balloting by the league's head coaches. Muhlenberg was picked to win the league this season, followed by Dickinson, Ursinus, Johns Hopkins, Moravian, Gettysburg, Franklin & Marshall, McDaniel, and Juniata.
- Juniata returns two players who earned All-Centennial accolades last season. Senior LB Josh Roy and junior DB Andy Miller were both Honorable Mention selections to the All-Centennial Conference Defense team.

**WELCOME TO COLLEGIATE FOOTBALL**

A total of 14 true freshmen played their first collegiate game in Juniata's season opener against Allegheny, including five who cracked the starting lineup: LT Brenton Bobal, RT Willie Reich, TB Dan Zentz, FB Ryan Blanchette and DT Jason Marquis. Redshirt freshman Jordan Baird also started at free safety, giving the Eagles six players who were making their first collegiate start in their first collegiate game.

There are 14 freshmen on Juniata's two-deep for the Dickinson game – six on offense, five on defense, and three on the special teams units (excluding Andrew Masullo, already listed with the defense). Another 12 are sophomores, with 13 juniors and just eight seniors, giving Juniata what may be one of the youngest teams in the Centennial Conference.

**O-LINE KEEPING LEONARD FROM GETTING SACK TIME**

Juniata's offensive line has allowed only two sacks over the past six games, after allowing 10 sacks through the first three contests of 2008.

Over the last six games, the Eagle O-line allowed one sack on the last play of the third quarter against Gettysburg, then allowed another sack late in the third quarter against Moravian. Juniata did not allow any sacks in the Johns Hopkins game.

**GIVEAWAY, TAKEAWAY**

A Juniata squad that was among the nation's best in taking care of the football in 2007, has struggled in that department during 2008.

The Eagles committed just 17 turnovers in all of last season, but have had at least three turnovers in five of their nine contests this season and have a total of 21 turnovers this season.

Juniata did not commit a single turnover against Johns Hopkins, the first time this season the Eagles have had a turnover-free game.

The Juniata defense has managed to prevent opponents from taking great advantage of those turnovers. The Eagles have allowed only five touchdowns and a field goal off those 21 turnovers; two of those scores were in the F&M game and occurred deep in Juniata territory, giving the Diplomats a short field with which to work.

Juniata has recorded 17 takeaways from their opponents. The Eagles have a -4 turnover margin this season, and are seventh in the Centennial Conference in that category.

**LEONARD STAYS IN PASSING LANE**

Senior quarterback Jay Leonard became the top passer in Juniata history with his 212 yards through the air against Ursinus. The Eagle signal caller currently has a total of 7,133 yards passing for his career, eclipsing the previous mark of 6,215 yards held by Greg Troutman (2001-04).

Leonard broke Troutman's career completion record in the win over McDaniel; he now has 607 completions for his career, surpassing the old record of 531.

Through nine games this season, Leonard has 1,464 yards passing, following his 2,360-yard performance last season that was the fourth-best single season passing effort in school history.

Leonard's 212 yards versus Ursinus was the 18th 200-yard passing performance of his career, tops among active quarterbacks in the Centennial Conference.

**WAVE THE BLACK FLAG**

Juniata's defensive unit – the "Black Flag defense" – has begun to find its place in a conference with several outstanding defensive squads. The Eagle defense is ranked fifth in the Centennial Conference this week, allowing 335.1 yards per game.

While that may place Juniata in the middle of the pack in the Centennial Conference, the Eagle "D" is anything but among all Division III teams.

Juniata is ranked 120th in Division III in total defense out of 235 teams, nearly placing the Eagle defense among the top half of all D-III defenses in the nation. In pass defense, Juniata ranks 54th in Division III, allowing 164.44 yards passing per game. In scoring defense, the Eagles check in at 85th in the nation at 20.67 points allowed per game.

### #2 Jay Leonard (Sr., QB, Newville, Pa./Big Spring)

Went over the 7,000-yard mark in career passing with 180 yards passing against Moravian College... was 15-of-35 passing for 125 yards in Juniata's last outing against Johns Hopkins... had a hand in all three Juniata touchdowns against Gettysburg, with two passing TDs and a one-yard rushing TD... the rushing TD was his third of the season and fifth of his career; he has rushing TDs earlier this season against Allegheny and McDaniel... passed for 212 yards (22-54-0) in loss at Ursinus, his 18th career 200-yard passing performance, and third of the season... threw for 206 yards in the opener against Allegheny, and 218 yards versus Susquehanna... threw his first TD pass of the season in the Ursinus game.
